

Arrangements for Slapton 2018

We will be staying at the Slapton Ley Field Centre, Slapton, Kingsbridge, Devon, TQ7 2QP.

Tuesday 25th September.

- 8:25am Meet outside Matrons with your luggage. Do not go to the form room.
- Arrive dressed in fieldwork clothing (boots/wellies can be put on when we arrive). Have your rucksack packed for the day's work (including pencils, any waterproofs, hats, gloves, etc). If you need travel sick pills make sure you have taken these beforehand.
- We provide the packed lunch and we will leave asap after 8:30am.
- 10:00-10:30 arrive at Slapton. We will be working on Slapton beach carrying out slope profiling and pebble analysis. You will be walking approximately 4 km.
- 5:00-6:30pm. Return to the centre, analyze results and then unpack/settle into your rooms. Keep your water bottles from school to reuse for the week.
- 7:00pm Dinner and then some free time.
- 8:00-9:00pm. Classroom session. Introduction to the river investigation
- 9:00-10:00pm Free time around the centre.
- 10:00pm All pupils to be in bedrooms. All electronic devices will be collected.
- 10:30pm Lights out and silence.

Wednesday 26th September.

- 7:00am Wakeup call and electronic devices returned. Make your own packed lunch.
