

Scholarship Awards - for September 2017/18

Detailed below are the Scholarship Awards which will be made available for the forthcoming 2017/18 Academic Year.

Awards are available in a number of different categories. ALL Scholarship awards are made on the basis of an academic assessment as outlined, plus, where appropriate, performance in a specific discipline, i.e. music or sport.

Head's Awards

The Head's Award can be made (at the discretion of the Head) to the best performing student/s in the Year Group. The value of the award can be up to 50% remission of fees and is available at all years from Reception upwards.

Academic Scholarships

Academic assessments will comprise OBJECTIVE assessments, bespoke tests, a portfolio of work, a school report and an interview with the Head. The value of this award is 25% remission of fees.

Music Scholarships

Music scholarships will be awarded as a result of a successful voice and/or instrument audition with the Director of Music. Typically at Senior level, Scholars would be of a standard equivalent to Grade 4 and above for Year 7 and Grade 5+ at Year 9, with a good standard of achievement in the academic tests. The value of this award is 25% remission of fees.

Sports Scholarships

Sports scholarships will be awarded subject to a successful trial at the school and a good standard of achievement in the academic tests. The value of this award is 25% remission of fees.

Local Fee

St John's no longer offers a local Scholarship. However as of September 2017/18 Academic Year, all those living within 15 miles of the school postcode, EX10 8RG, as the crow flies, postcode to postcode as defined by Google will be eligible to apply for the Local Fee rate published in our Fees information.
